

ellisburg-oscar-albro

Facts and timeline for Oscar Albro from Cayuga County and Ellisburg, New York

1850 - Federal census, Victory, Cayuga County, NY, 3 months old, with parents Oliver and Orpha and siblings, Walter, Warren, Electa, Manerva (Minerva) and Olive.

1860 - Federal census, Ellisburg, Jefferson County, NY 9 years old, father Oliver, stepmother Lydia, siblings, Warren, Asel, Minerva, Cordelia.

19 July, 1864 - hurt with towline on Canal, age 14, (Onondaga County Poorhouse Records), newspaper article gives age as 15 or 16; lad gives his name as Oscar Albro, states his father is Oliver Albro and lives in Jefferson County, New York.

1870 - not found with family on census or elsewhere.

2 July, 1876 - married by J.W. Martin to Emma Goodrich, both of Sandy Creek, NY

1880 - not found

1883 - named as nephew, Sandy Creek, NY in Lyman Albro's will.

1900 - not found

1910 - not found

8 June, 1918 - died at Hospital of the Good Shepherd, Syracuse, NY. Parents given as Oliver and Orfia Dickerson, birthdate as 4 July, 1862, former residence, Buffalo, NY. Marital status given is "widowed". (death certificate)

Notes: "widowed", but wife Emma Goodrich (remarried to Farmer) did not die until 1922. Death certificate gives Mannsville, NY as place of burial or removal. Newspaper says removal to Ellisburg for burial; grave has not been found; he is not listed with the other Albro family members in the Ellisburg Cemetery.

Syracuse, NY Post Standard - "Mystery man" identified by brother William Albro, a farmer from Ellisburg. "Mystery man" refused to give information about himself, other than his name and age, even though he knew he was dying.

1922 - Emma Farmer (Goodrich/Albro) died.
